



PRESS COMMUNIQUE

The Tourism Authority hereby invites applications for commercial pleasure craft licences, in respect of any embarkation point in replacement of existing commercial pleasure craft licences which have lapsed.

In line with the current policy in force, new licences will be issued to Mauritians who are **NOT** already holders of any commercial pleasure craft licence or shareholders and/or directors of companies holding a commercial pleasure craft licence. Priority of consideration will be given to innovative projects.

The application should be accompanied by the following documents:

- i. All applicants whether individual, shareholders or Directors must declare that they have a clean record. Should the application be successful, then the successful applicant must submit a certificate of character prior to issue of licence.
- ii. Curriculum Vitae (Profile of Applicant).
- iii. Business Plan.
- iv. Proof of Source of Funds as follows:
 1. if leasing or contracting loan from bank: to submit Letter of Comfort from Bank; and
 2. if using own funds, to submit Statement of Account for the past six months.

The closing date for submission of application is Monday 15 July, 2019 at 1600 hours.

The Tourism Authority reserves the right not to issue any licence following this communiqué
