



POST CONSTRUCTION ASSESSMENT (PCA) APPLICATION FORM

A. Eligibility Criteria

1. Craft should have been constructed by manufacturers who have a track record of competence and reliability in the domain. Craft constructed by individuals or new entrants in the business may be considered subject to an inspection of their factories.

2. Craft should not be more than 10 years of age.
